# **Cookies Policy**

Allstate Northern Ireland ("us", "we", or "our") uses cookies on <a href="https://www.allstateni.com/">https://www.allstateni.com/</a> (the "Service"). By using the Service, you consent to the use of cookies.

Our Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third-parties we may partner with may use cookies on the Service, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

#### What are cookies?

Cookies are a small text file sent to your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the Service or a third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you.

Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies.

Persistent cookies are cookies saved on your computer and are not deleted automatically when you quit your browser. Session cookies are deleted when you quit your browser.

#### How Allstate Northern Ireland uses cookies

When you use and access the Service, we may place a number of cookie files in your web browser.

We use cookies to enable certain functions of the Service, to provide analytics and to store your preferences.

We use both session and persistent cookies on the Service, and we use different types of cookies to run the Service:

#### Essential cookies.

These cookies are necessary for the Service to operate. These are cookies that must be included in order for the service to function. For this reason, they do not require consent and are always set on. Operational cookies refer to authentication cookies and technical cookies required by certain IT systems.

# **Analytics Cookies**

We use these purely for internal research on how we can improve the service for all users. These cookies simply assess how you interact with the service as an anonymous user, the data gathered does not identify you personally. We drop these cookies and use Adobe to help us analyse the data.

The anonymised statistics could be shared with contractors working on communications projects under contractual agreement with Allstate Northern Ireland.
